ii. Financial Report

Mr. Whisman indicated that more districts and the Department of Education were paying us so receivable and cash were normalizing as it should be. Current ratios and cash on hand exceed industry standards. Mr. Marous inquired if the EOY projection was reliable. Mr. Whisman indicated that while it did depend on continued enrollment figures, there were no red flags to indicate that the prediction would not be reliable. Mr. Marous also asked Mrs. Rossetti about mid-year enrollment figures and whether or not supply issues would be a factor. Mrs. Rossetti indicated that most students are staying with the school. We are projecting 120 new enrollments for mid-year and have the Chromebook supply to accommodate this number. He further asked if the SY20-21 budget should be rebudgeted and Mrs. Rossetti answered in the affirmative.

iii. Budget SY20-21

Mrs. Heiles, R & D Coordinator, presented a proposal to establish a Community Connection Program. Under this program, the Family Engagement Team would have three vehicles at their disposal to use to travel throughout the state support families, transition from post high-school, and promote community engagement. She emphasized that this is not a program to replace or add to our existing model but rather to enhance and pull together other existing programs such

as field trips, college visits, job shadowing, technology, health screenings, etc. The plan would call for a \$300,000 investment in three vehicles and the hiring of several additional family engagement coaches (which were allocated in our Strategic Plan).

Mr. Marous asked if this proposal would go against our current charter and Mrs. Rossetti explained that it did not. He also asked how often would the coaches be on the road and what would be the process. Mrs. Heiles explained that the first step after the vehicle purchases would be to establish a yearly calendar of events. Travel of the certified staff would not be mandatory but their collaboration in the project would be helpful. He asked about vehicle utilization and Mr. Heiles explained that the school was targeting two weeks a month with two weeks in the office for collaboration but that this was not set in stone. Mr. Dolan asked how this could interact with Career Education Work and Mrs. Rossetti provided an example of a field trip to a zoo. The zoo trip would be a field trip, but if a student was interested in a career in this field, they could potentially meet with a zoo staff member and schedule a job shadowing. On these trips, students could receive their health screenings. There could be enhanced technology training. An ideal coach would be non-certified, charismatic and able to hold an audience. While there was some skepticism in the program, the Board Members did indicate support. Mrs. Rossetti explained that while there were some very tangible benefits for the students, there would also be benefits for the staff members in getting to know our student population.

The SY20-21 re-budget was presented and the Board felt that it was sufficiently conservative and challenged the administrative team to continue searching for new and innovative programs.
